
Water Quality Study Notes


Freshwater

2. Water is easily polluted because many substances <u>dissolve</u> in it.






3. <u>Wastes</u> from microorganisms and decomposing matter can create a bad <u>odor</u> and dark color in water.




4. One biotic factor that can influence the number of microorganisms present is food.

6. The high salt content of sea water affect its' usefulness to people by <u>reducing</u> the number of ways that people can <u>use</u> it.





7. The <u>least</u> expensive way for communities to deal with water shortages is to <u>conserve</u> water.





8. Communities along a river decide how to manage their river by studying the issues and holding public meetings






9. A major <u>abiotic</u> factor that affects freshwater

ecosystems is the <u>speed</u> of water.









10. A lake becomes a forest when it fills with sediment over time.



11. Because water can <u>dissolve</u> many substances it allows substances spilled on the soil to be carried into underground water supplies.



14. Building a dam on a river will cause the <u>plant</u> and <u>fish</u> Populations to change.




15. Mining in an area might reduce pH and add heavy metals to <u>stream</u> water.



16. <u>Farming</u> is one activity in Utah that requires a <u>lot</u> of water.




17. Wetlands replenish underground water supplies by helping the surface water move deeper in the ground.
